What will Chorus be like

- **What will we do during the rehearsals?** We will be singing and rehearsing a variety of music in preparation for our annual holiday and spring concerts. We will also prepare for auditions for the SAMS annual musical.

A variety of activities such as community building games, warmup activities, vocal health discussions and assessment recordings will be included in the Day 3 and 5 rehearsals.

- **How will I learn new music on my own?** Sound tracks will be provided for individual practice outside of rehearsals.

How will I be graded in Chorus?

- Participation in rehearsals.
- One performance based assessment approx. each month - We're aiming for growth, not perfection.
- Attention and participation in the two annual performances.

What music will we sing?

- There is a wide variety of music that we will use to get us started. You will also have access to a chorus music library in Noteflight Learn (an online music program). I'll help you through everything - so don't be anxious or overwhelmed!

Why should I join 6th grade Chorus?

- Think of Chorus as your "**school family**". It's a place to connect, make and see friends, and learn something that you hopefully enjoy and will use for the rest of your life!
- There are two evening **performances** for this year. The dates for those performances are Thursday December 1, 2022 and Thursday, April 27, 2023.
- **Concerts** are required and are heavily **graded**.
