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Course Description: This course reviews the study of chord progressions on the keyboard and then transitions the chord progressions to the acoustic guitar. Students will explore the history, manufacturing and the playing skills of the acoustic guitar. Students demonstrate the skills by playing an accompaniment to a children's song.

Students will discover the world of Jazz. They will explore the beginnings of this unique American music genre. Students will analyze the individual unique sounds of jazz musicians and will compare and identify the musician.

Objectives/Goals:

- Review the 12 bar blues chord progression on keyboards.
- Explores the use of music technology.
- Demonstrate basic skills in playing a guitar
- Practice/Rehearsal/Performance: continue to encourage effective practice and rehearsal habits.
- Study the culture and historical context of Jazz music
- Analyze the unique sound of jazz musicians
