SASHS Band Contract

Dear band student and parent,

Welcome to a new and exciting year as a part of the SASHS Band. I have high expectations for the quality of music and performance both on and off the field. To help insure a successful year, please read and complete the attached contract and return it to Band Boosters.

Guidelines for activities and performance:

- 1. During all band activities, the SASD's policies and procedures, as listed in the student handbook, are in effect.
- 2. Students should arrive on time for all band activities.
- 3. Manner of dress for all activities will be dictated by Mr. Maag and enforced by the chaperones.
- 4. Full uniform will consist of baldric, jacket, band t-shirt, shoes, gloves, gauntlets and hat. All-white socks that go above the ankle and light colored lightweight pants or shorts (no cargos or jeans!) are a must under the bibs.
- 5. Absolutely no tank tops, halters or shirts with no sleeves are to be worn under the uniform jacket.
- 6. Bibs, band t-shirt, socks and shoes will be worn on the bus going to and from activities that require this type of dress.
- 7. Uniforms, which cost \$600-\$700 per set, are to be handled with care and properly hung on their hangers after each use, unless designated to go to the cleaners. Uniforms are to be returned to the school on their original uniform hangers.
- 8. Band shoes are to be kept clean and periodically polished to provide a finished look to the uniform.
- 9. Do **not** wear or use facial make-up, perfumes, face or hair paint, aerosol spray deodorant or hair spray due while in uniform due to possible allergic reactions of other students or damage to the uniforms. **NO** long earrings (they are not a part of the uniform).
- 10. While in uniform in the stands, band students will sit on covered bleachers.
- 11. All spills or stains on the uniform should be immediately reported to the chaperones.
- 12. Chaperones are given strict guidelines by Mr. Maag. Chaperones will inform the student(s) once for an infraction of the rules and will inform the student(s) to abide by said rules. If problems continue, chaperones will inform Mr. Maag, who will then administer the consequences.
- 13. The "buddy system" will be used during away band activities.
- 14. All show and parade music will be memorized.
- 15. All students are expected to participate in all events. The attendance policy will be discussed at band camp and the first day of school.
- 16. NO food or drink in the stands. NO gum.
- 17. Parents are to ensure that their student is picked up at the designated place and time after an event.
